



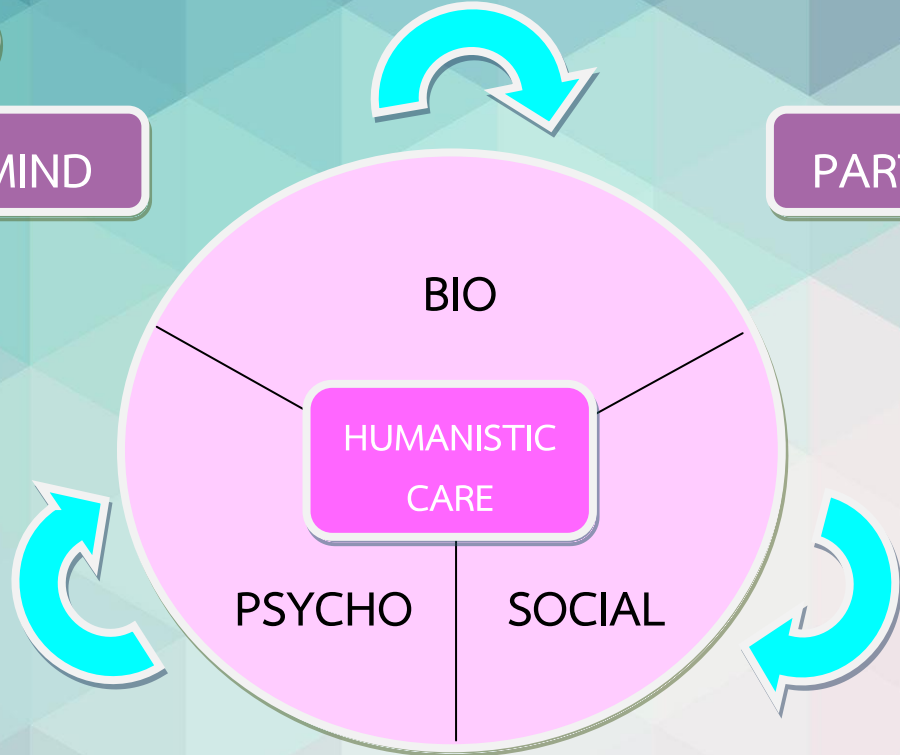

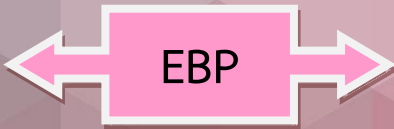
Aim. This paper is a report of a review of the quantitative evidence for medium to high fidelity nursing process and analytical thinking in nursing, in comparison to other educational strategies.
