Gamma-O-Rama provides opportunity to:

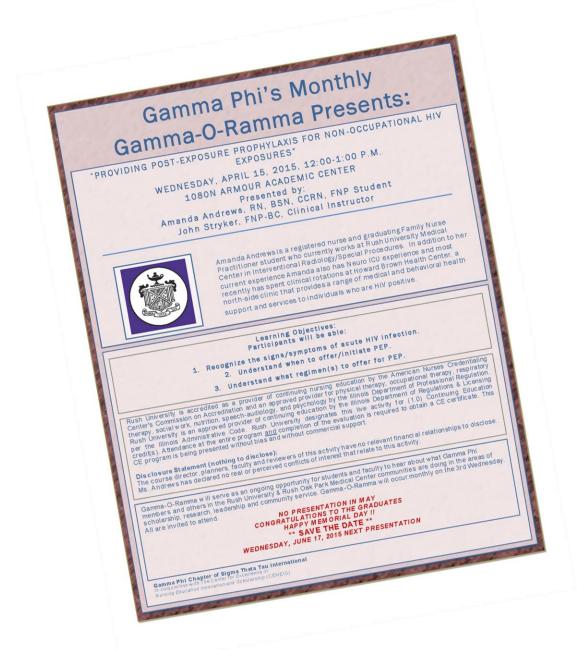
- Engage members

- Demonstrate the chapter's commitment to lifelong learning.

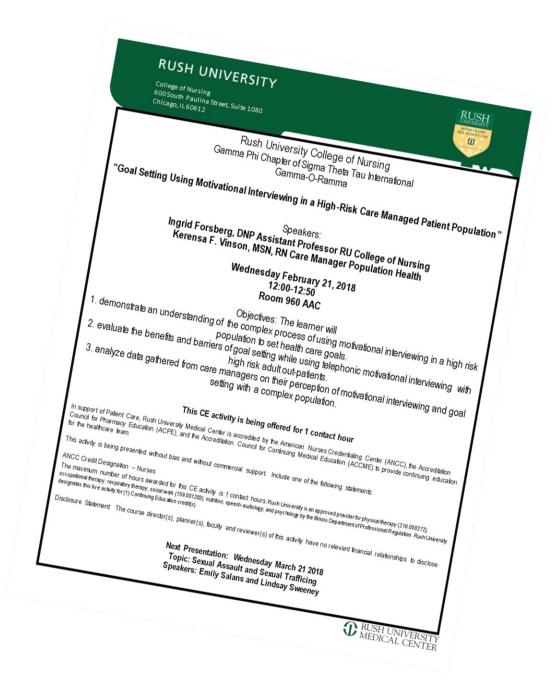
These opportunities

Tips for Success

Gamma-O-Rama is a success:

- Average of 25 attendees per month.
- Program evaluations consistently rated greater than 4 on a 5 pt. scale





Chapter leaders attribute this success to several factors:

- Gamma-O-Rama is branded
- Consistency programs offered 8 to 10 times a year always on the third Wednesday at noon
- Varied speakers nursing faculty, practicing nurse leaders, DNP and CNL students
- Supports all speakers seasoned as well as new or first time speakers
- Varied topics address United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDG)
- grant funded work
- evidence-based initiative
- innovative academic programs
- successful community programs
- global volunteer projects
- collaborative work between DNP and PhD prepared nurses
- issues surrounding diversity (a recent standingroom only offering).
- Free continuing education hours for attendees
- Each session offered at the main medical center and our community partner

How to Replicate

The Board of Directors should designate a separate committee to manage the program.

Committee members are responsible for:

- Recruiting speakers
- Sending out flyers (electronic and display in house) to all chapter members and well as targeted audience members depending on the topic
- Introducing members at the forums
- Sending completed attendance record and CE forms to continuing education office

Each of these responsibilities, in addition to presenting at the forum, are opportunities for leadership.

Future Considerations

For sustainability, Gamma-O-Rama needs to evolve Ideas include:

- Teleconferencing the sessions to the expanding healthcare system
- Presenting collaborative work with community members
- Adapting to a lunch & learn format and provide lunch for attendees
- Conducting a members' needs/interest assessment for future topics
