Definition of Ambulatory Care Nursing

Professional ambulatory care nursing:

- Complex, multi-faceted specialty
- Encompasses independent and collaborative practice
- Partners with health professionals across the span of the health continuum

Focuses on health care for individuals, families, groups, communities and populations

Practice is built on a broad base of evidence in nursing and health sciences, applying nursing knowledge and expertise through the nursing process to ensure:

- Patient safety
- Quality processes
- Improved patient and organizational outcomes

Settings for Professional Practice

- Hospital-based outpatient clinics and centers
- Solo/group medical practices
- Ambulatory surgery and medical diagnostic procedure centers
- Telehealth encounters in the virtual environment
- University and community settings
- Nurse-managed clinics
- Military and VA clinics
- HMOs and ACOs
- Patient homes and residences
- Care Coordination settings

Importance of a Conceptual Framework for Ambulatory Care Nursing

- Presents a "global view" and visual depiction of ambulatory care nursing
- Illustrates main concepts and their interrelationships
- Serves as the organizing framework for practice
- Provides direction for research of phenomena of interest
- Guides curriculum development
- Changes as ambulatory care nursing advances


Value of the Conceptual Framework for Ambulatory Care Nursing

A conceptual framework provides a blueprint for ambulatory care nursing,

- Strategic and operational planning
- Design of ambulatory care practice models
- Development of testing materials that identify nurse competencies for ambulatory care certification
- Development of educational curricula and materials
- Development of orientation programs
- Research study design (Mastal, 2013, pp.7-8)


Conceptual Framework: Version I

Ambulatory Care Nursing Conceptual Framework Diagram



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


Ambulatory Care Nursing Conceptual Framework Diagram
