







Nurses by Practice Area



Have you ever had to treat a mental health patient?




Have you had any additional training in mental health after nursing school?

Data Dive

- ♦ Non-parametric distribution, so Sign Test used for overall scores
 - ♦ Statistically significant increase in the overall scores from pre- to postintervention
 - ♦ Statistically significant increases in all four domain scores








ED vs. Non-ED Baseline Scores
