Description/Overview:

This presentation will include information on a learner-paced online study-guide program aimed to prepare academic nurse educators for the Certified Nurse Educator (CNE) credentialing examination. This six-course program is engaging, featuring interactive practice scenarios, knowledge checks, and downloadable resources.

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Author Summary: This workshop was designed from Dunker's DNP capstone project, which responds the nursing faculty shortage. The orientation program is based on competencies from the NLN, QSEN, and Nurse of the Future. This clinical orientation has been offered statewide at many regional workshops in Massachusetts and at QSEN for 3 consecutive years. Data from this study show that competency based clinical faculty orientation is effective in preparing clinical faculty to work at the bedside.
