Lessons Learned: Systems Review

- Purpose: Describe the development, testing, modifications and results of the Quality Cost Model of Advanced Practice Nurses Transitional Care
- Method: Seven Randomized Clinical Trials
- Findings: Improved patient outcomes and reduced health care costs across all groups
- Conclusions: To Improve health over time, NPs must have a depth of knowledge, excellent clinical skills, interpersonal skills, understanding of systems, sufficient patient contact






Where's the Evidence?

- * Brooten, et al. (2002) tested the quality cost model of nurse practitioner based care with favorable outcome.
- Evidence-based practice is considered the optimal goal and was encouraged by Melnyk & Fineout-Overholt (2011).
- * Nurse Practitioners can lead the staff to higher levels of understanding of the need for evidence-based practice and encourage staff participation in education and research.
