d in analyzing the essential

This study utilizes Van Manen's method in analyzing the essential meaning of the nurses hospice and ICU experience. Six activities are used to examine and understand the experience:

- 1. Turning to the nature of the lived experience
- 2. Exploring the experience as we live it
- 3. Reflecting on essential themes
- 4. Describing the phenomenon through the art of writing and rewriting
- 5. Maintaining a strong relation to the phenomenon
- 6. Balancing the research context by considering parts and whole.







The thematization process, used to detail the bits and pieces of reality, consists of four reflections:

- 1. Profile of co-researchers, textual transcription of their experiences and individual themes
- 2. Composite themes arising from co-researcher's experiences
- 3. Interlaced theme on common ground
- 4. Elicit eidetic insight or the vivid gist of the theme.







