## Summary / Conclusion

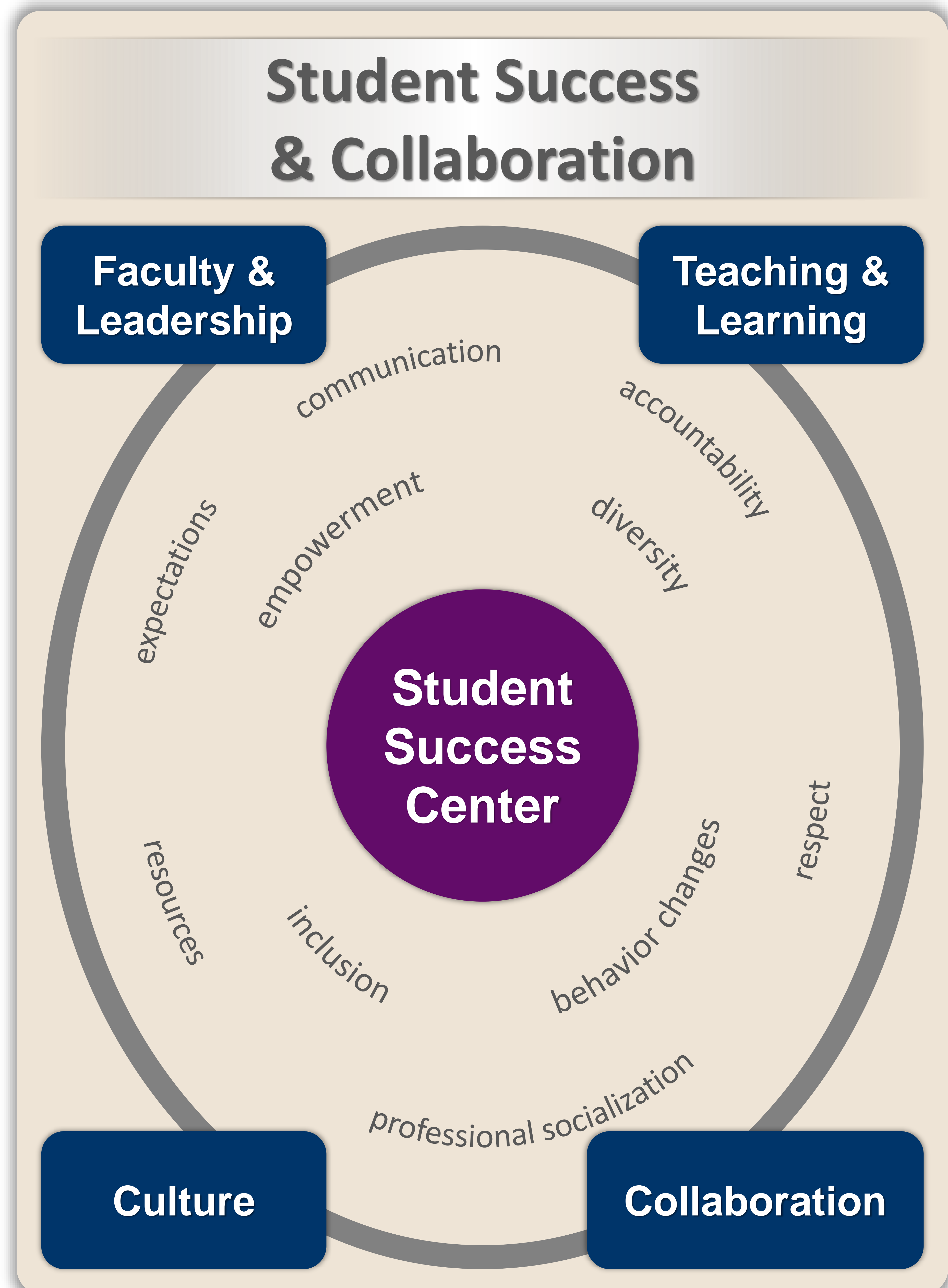
- Collaboration plays an important role in academic success
