<b>LEARNING OBJECTIVES</b>	<b>EXPANDED CONTENT OUTLINE</b>
Explain the purpose, procedures, and findings for a research study that explored the knowledge of women in rural Uganda regarding HIV/AIDS	Introduction will be presented with the concept of global health, and how the opportunity was presented for this research. The purpose regarding the global health issue of HIV/AIDS and dilemma of education reaching remote areas in Uganda. The correlation between education and health promoting behavior changes will be emphasized. The methods (2 focus groups in two rural villages in Uganda) and analysis of that data will be shared. The findings of three major themes: The basic knowledge of the women, poor access to treatment and prevention strategies, and concern more about reliable contraception than fears concerning HIV/AIDS.
Apply the findings from a study of the knowledge of women in rural Uganda regarding knowledge of HIV/AIDS to global health concerns	Continuing with the powerpoint presentation the researcher will make connections to the conference theme of global health and how cultural considerations are related to changes in health promoting behaviors.
