A standard process was used to develop the McKellar Guidelines with some additional components such as evaluating successive iterations of the Guidelines in the clinical setting
After the presentation the learner will be able to describe the value of consulting with key stakeholder groups throughout the development process	Key stakeholder groups; staff and older people with diabetes, were actively involved in developing and evaluating the McKellar Guidelines. Engaging key stakeholders enhanced the clinical relevance of the Guidelines.
After attending the presentation the learner will be able to discuss the role and value of expert consensus opinion to guideline development processes.	Expert and consensus opinion is generally regarded as being less valuable than randomised control trial evidence. However, it has a key role when such evidence is not available and enhances clinical relevance of the content.
