The learner will be able to realize the relationship among cachexia syndrome, symptom distress, and quality of life in pancreatic cancer patients.	A structured questionnaire with Fatigue Symptom Inventory, Symptom Severity Scale, and Functional Assessment of Cancer Therapy-General Scale were used to collect patients'™ fatigue, symptom distress and QoL, and the generalized estimating equation (GEE) was used to examine the significant associated factors with QoL after operation.
