Participants will discover the importance of using a participatory approach to involve bedside nurses, and other disciplines in the conduct of nurse-led research to overcome insufficient older adult mobilization.	To overcome the barriers that nurses may encounter to promote the mobility of hospitalized older adults, bedside nurses need to be engaged in nurse-led research.
Further, participants will learn how using a participatory approach may serve as a springboard to build capacity for nurse-led research at the bedside.	Using an interdisciplinary participatory approach to conduct nurse-led research in the clinical setting is beneficial to generate a culture of inquiry in nurses with varying educational degrees, and in a variety of roles, and other disciplines. This has resulted in the generation of other, relevant research studies, and evidence-based practice projects with the overarching aim of improving mobility in hospitalized older adults.
