Describe a cross disciplinary sustainable approach to water, sanitation and hygiene challenges in developing countries.	Overview of project background and history including: 1) description of the cross disciplinary service learning approach; 2) course evolution from faculty driven to student driven; 3) strategies which support sustainability; 4) the utility of cross disciplinary approaches to global health challenges; and 5) impact of cross discipline work on professional development for a variety of disciplines.
Discuss the efficacy of using a participatory research approach to global challenges.	Overview of the participatory research approach including: 1) building trust; 2) community engagement; 3) challenges and benefits; and 4) impact on community health and well-being.
Identify the impact of cross disciplinary global health projects on the competencies, attitudes and commitment towards global health by nursing faculty, students and other disciplines.	Summarize faculty and student impacts related to: 1) global health viewpoint and commitment; 2) the role of nurses in global health; 3) enhancement of leadership and scholarship; and 4) future career choices/educational preparation .
