Compare and contrast health care delivery systems of the United Kingdom, Israel, and the United States.	The health care systems of the United Kingdom, Israel, and the United States represent the continuum of health care access, ranging from full access in the United Kingdom to limited access to care in the United States.
2. Identify blocks that vulnerable population groups encounter in all health systems.	Each country had vulnerable population groups that experienced significant blocks to accessing health care due to systematic lack of cultural competence and linguistic concordance.
3. Formulate strategies that nurses can implement to ameliorate blocks for health care access in all three countries' health systems.	Regardless of location, nurses serve as the critical link between people who need care and health care systems. Improved health outcomes depend on proactive outreach and research with members of vulnerable groups.
