LEARNING OBJECTIVES	EXPANDED CONTENT OUTLINE
The learner will be able to discuss the relevance of nurse perceptions about caring for people living with HIV (PLHIV) as an important area for research to inform evidence-based practice.	A brief overview of the various studies specific to nurses and students will be described. The relationship between faculty and student attitudes will be discussed. And, the gap in the literature, or faculty attitudes about caring for PLHIV will be identified.
The learner will be able to identify the Healthcare Provider HIV/AIDS Stigma Scale (HPASS) and the three subscales, discrimination, stereotypes, and prejudices.	In relationship to the HPASS, the general attitudes towards caring for PLHIV will be presented as well as the factors that influence attitudes to HIV.
The learner will be able to explain the nursing faculty attitudes to caring for PLHIV in terms of discrimination, stereotypes, and prejudices.	In depth analysis of the data will be presented in terms of attitudes associated with discrimination, stereotypes, and prejudices.
