Pathways to Progress: Academic Support for Students in Nursing Education Programs

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Future Predictions & Questions

 Nursing Workforce needs are expected to increase 16% by 2024 (Board of Labor, 2017). • Do Academic Support Programs adequately retain and graduate students from BSN programs?

- Will Nursing Programs be ready to meet the needs of society?
- Is there evidence to support the inclusion of Academic Support Programs for BSN programs?

Problem: Attrition in the BSN Program

Issue:

• Students do not understand why they are not successful and loose confidence.

Approach:

- Policy permits 1 nursing course to be repeated.
- Fortify student abilities while they repeat the course.
- Develop an Academic Support Course to strengthen student achievement.
- "Teach Students How to Learn"

- 3 credit course
- Take concurrently while repeating nursing course
- Guides and supports students to acquire and strengthen confidence levels, study skills, test taking skills and critical thinking.
 - Students who complete NURS 234 are assigned an Academic Coach for the remainder of the program.

Course Description

 Pathways to Progress course is designed as a <u>personalized system</u> of instruction that will result in student achievement of nursing course and curricular objectives in which there is a known deficiency. Student will participate in the course the semester <u>when they repeat</u> <u>a nursing</u> course. Student will be permitted to continue to progress in the program after successful completion of the course.

- Course Outcome Objectives
 - Demonstrate proficiency in time management regarding academics.
 - Demonstrate proficiency in reading comprehension.
 - Utilize successful test-taking strategies.

- Apply clinical reasoning appropriate to the level of progress in the program.
- Apply nursing principles and practices to simulated situations.
- Formulate a roadmap for ongoing success.

 - Note taking
 - Time Management
 - Stress Management
 - Language of Healthcare
 - Reading comprehension
 - Test taking strategies
 - Critical Thinking/Problem Solving

 - Pro-active
 - Mentor relationship in Academic Coaching
 - Participate in professional events
 - Peer Mentorin

- Continue tracking retention outcomes in those students who complete NURS 234.
- Identify achievement of Nursing licensure in those students who completed NURS 234.
- Offer this course to everyone.
- Shift from remediation to enrichment.
